Each project will require Engineered NY State approved stamped plans.

Each awarded bidder will be required to conform to the requirements of all Federal, State, and local codes and ordinances, and obtain all permits and inspections as required.

Each bidder must comply with the New York State Labor Law, including the payment of prevailing wages.

The Village Board of the Village of Groton reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities at its discretion.
