In addition to direct costs paid by the Village for such training and/or education, reimbursable expenses incurred in the cost of training may include but shall not be limited to reimbursement made by the Village to an individual for the cost of travel, lodging, meals, books, registration and tuition, as the case may be.

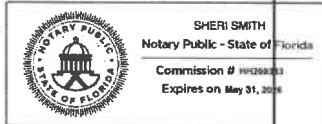
