The annual review of accounting and investment policies was completed with the update to chapter 33-7 Designation of depositories in the past year, no other changes have been made.

Presentation and Discussion with Rich Cunningham from Thoma Development on possible grants.

CDBG grants could be due as early as the beginning of July. We should consider looking at documenting housing addition survey. This would be a full survey of our Village. This would be due around the end of July and could be up to \$50,000, this would help us to be in place for a future housing grant. We would most likely need a public hearing in June or July. This would be an exterior evaluation of the houses. Most multi unit properties are not included. Mr. Cunningham will prepare a proposal to apply for the grant for the survey.

NY Forward Grant - There will be a lot of work on our part. We need a committee - school, bank, community members. Put forth potential projects that are realistic. The Village will work on putting a committee together.
