LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2024

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 87 of the Code of the Village of Groton to amend Chapter 87, "Dogs and Other Animals", Article I "Keeping of Animals", Paragraph 87-1 "Animals at Large", therefore by replacing Section 87-1 with a new Section 87-1.

Section 1. Chapter 87 of the Code of the Village of Groton is hereby amended to amend Section 87-1 to read as follows:

§87-1. Keeping Livestock and Fowl.

No person shall harbor, or cause to be harbored, any livestock including horses, goats, cattle, sheep, or swine within the limits of the Village of Groton, except on premises having an area in excess of 5 acres. Permits are required for livestock. Fowl, such as chicken hens, are permitted in the Village with a limit of 6 per household. Roosters or any other poultry are not permitted. No person shall suffer the above livestock and/or fowl to be at large or to be driven through the streets within the Village of Groton.

Section 2.
