Annually, each residential electric customer of participating Municipal Electric Utilities is eligible for one (1) incentive payment up to 75% of the cost up to a maximum IEEP incentive of \$5,000 of the installation expense incurred. Eligible measures include: **Attic insulation, exterior wall insulation, rim joist insulation, basement crawl space insulation, air sealing, weatherstripping, duct insulation, and ventilation.** All projects must be pre-approved by the IEEP in order to be eligible.

**For pre-approval,** please submit this completed form, a copy of your electric bill, and a detailed scope of work from your selected insulation contractor clearly listing all work and costs listed separately. The IEEP will return a pre-approval authorization and then the work can commence.
