

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Village of Groton

The Village of Groton will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, January 20th, 2026, at 7:35pm. Residents may attend in person at the Village Office, 308 Main Street, Groton, NY 13073. The hearing is held for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Village of Groton's current Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Project 487CP144-24, which was awarded \$44,000, for the development of a village-wide housing conditions report. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and provides resources to eligible local governments for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The hearing will provide further information about the progress of the ongoing CDBG project. Comments related to the effectiveness of administration of the CDBG project will also be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The location of hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities.
